We Need Election Officials

Election Officials are needed at various polling locations *on Election Day*. Election Officials are paid for their work. Training is provided.

Duties of an Election Official

- Staff a polling site on Election Day
- Set up in the morning and help break down the polling site enclosure at the end of the election
- Check-in voters when they arrive at the polling site
- Issue ballots to voters when they have completed the initial check-in process
- Assist voters as needed and upon request

Hours: 5:30 A.M. - 8:00 P.M. Election Day

Qualifications to be an Election Official

- You must be a registered voter in Franklin County or be a high school student who is at least 17 years old and is in good academic standing
 - NOT SURE OF REGISTRATION? Check here: <https://vt.ncsbe.gov/RegLKup/>
- Precinct officials may not be a candidate or relative of a candidate in the election
- They may not be an elected government official, hold office with a political party, manager or treasurer for a candidate or political party
- They may not serve at the same polling site as a spouse, child, sister, brother, spouse of a child

We Need Poll Greeters and Poll Observers

Poll observers needed for *Election Day*. Poll greeters needed for *Early Voting & Election Day*

Poll Observer:

- Sit in the polling site and observe the election process.
- Ensure that voters' rights are upheld and protected and that no voter is disenfranchised from voting. Work is done in four-hour shifts. **This is critically important work!**
- **Training Required:** Training is provided by the Franklin Co. Democratic Party.

Poll Greeter:

- Pass out campaign literature and voting information to voters outside of a designated polling site.
